

BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION PLAN

NOTIFICATION:

The **Notification** tab documents meeting information, meeting participants, and parental contact. No changes were made to this tab during the redesign of the BIP.

SIGNATURES:

The **Signatures** tab allows users to add electronic signatures for districts where the Electronic Signatures feature is enabled. This tab does not appear for districts where the Electronic Signatures feature is off. No changes were made to this tab during the redesign of the BIP.

TARGET BEHAVIORS:

- A **Target Behavior** tab has been added to the **BIP** record
 - The following fields are included
 - **Target Behavior 1**
 - **Description of target behavior**
 - **Hypothesis**, which includes a set of prompts
 - The tab requires at least one target behavior, but allows space for two target behaviors to be included
- Data from the **FBA** is promoted to this section of the **BIP**
